

The pool is not quite ready due to the City's non-scope of construction but should be completed by the time you read this. The LAPRAAC Board of Directors apologizes for any inconvenience, but we want to have the facility completely ready when it opens.

The Sports Awards banquet took place Thursday, November 17, 2016, at the Elysian Park GYM. The return to the Elysian Park facility for the Awards Banquet was a success. Those in attendance were very complimentary about the food and decorations. The entertainment was hilarious and well received.

# Wellness Corner Sleep to Better Health

Millions of Americans have trouble sleeping. And poor sleep may be costing you more than fatigue.

#### **Sleep deprivation is connected to numerous health problems:**

- ✓ People with insomnia or sleep apnea (breathing cessation) have increased risk for cardiovascular conditions, such as high blood pressure, stroke, coronary heart disease and irregular heartbeat.
- ✓ Insufficient sleep raises the risk for type 2 diabetes, depression and metabolic changes linked to obesity.

- Seventy-six percent to 83% of exercisers (including vigorous, moderate and light exercisers) said their sleep quality was very good or fairly good.
- Non-exercisers are twice as likely as exercisers to have sleep apnea, a major risk for heart trouble.

**Identify your sleep robbers**. Is worry keeping you awake? Maybe it's caffeine (especially close to bedtime) or medications, pain, indigestion or other physical problems. Record your sleep patterns for a month to identify the culprits.

'The referring LAPFCU member must be 18 years or older and must refer a qualified member 18 or older to earn a \$50 deposit when the referee joins LAPFCU. \$50 deposit will be made to the referring member's \$1 Share Savings Account within 60 days of the referral. \*The referred new member must be 18 or older and open up a membership with a checking account, sign up for a minimum monthly direct deposit or ACH credit of \$250 or more, and opt-in to e-Statements and e-Disclosures, before the end of six months from membership opening, in order to receive \$100. The \$100 deposit will be made to his or her \$1 Share Savings Account within 60 days once the six month period has ended. The \$100 bonus is considered dividends and will be reported on IRS Form 1099-INT. \*Membership charter includes active and retired, sworn and civilian employees of county or municipal police departments or sheriff's offices in Los Angeles County and their immediate families. Immediate family is defined as: spouse, domestic partner, child, sibling, parent, grandparent, grandparent, grandparent, step-sibling, adopted child, legal guardianships: Domestic partnership eligibility is limited to a member's domestic partner, as defined in LAPFCU's Affidavit of Domestic Partnership; legal guardianship is defined by a court order. The class is scheduled for Friday, January 13. LAPRAAC members will receive a discounted class price.




