

This is an event that LAPRAAC and the Department will be proud of as we recognize the officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice. The kids' fun run and an open race are still in the plans. Consideration is being made to bring back the team relay competition in addition to the popular Platoon Run. This event is for the memory of our partners and friends who are on the wall.

While we are thinking of our fallen officers I would encourage all of our members to support the Police Unity Tour and our local chapter, the Southern California Police Unity Tour (SOCALPUT). The primary purpose of the Police Unity Tour is to raise awareness of the Police Officers who have died in the line of duty. The secondary purpose is to raise funds for the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial (NLEOM). Those involved with the SOCALPUT will ride their bicycles 225 miles, from Somerset New Jersey on May 9th, 2016 to the NLEOM in Washington DC on May 12, 2016. The riders' motto "We ride for those who died," keeps them going on this demanding ride. That motto is not enough for SOCALPUT to support the Memorial - they need our support through donations. I urge all of you to go to www.socalput.org and donate to the organization or to an individual runner. I know you will see the name of a rider who was your partner, classmate or friend. Tell them thank you and donate to our National Memorial.

Finally, with the expectation that the Academy will open sometime this fall we are working to begin operations in the refurbished main building and open the Café. The Administrative and Projects Committees are working with our General Manager to find the right company to operate the Café and catering operations for LAPRAAC. We are looking forward to the improvements at the Academy so we can offer you the best in activities, programs and food service.
